A / Castell Macabeu Chardonnay / Catalonia, Spain

9.25 / 11.25 / 22.50 / 30.75

Pale yellow in colour with aromas of peach and pineapple on the nose. On the palate it is fresh with intense fruity flavours and good acidity.

B / Penny Lane Sauvignon Blanc / New Zealand

9.75 / 11.75 / 23.50 / 31.75

Aromas of pineapple, gooseberries and guava dominate. The weighty palate presents a zesty lime backbone and a lengthy finish.

REDS

C / Santa Digna Merlot / Chile

9.25 / 11.25 / 22.50 / 30.75

This Reserve Merlot has great aromatic intensity; plum and blackberry jam mixed with spicy hints of vanilla and liquorice. An attractive and elegant palate leads onto a spicy toasty oak finish. Fair Trade.

D / Rioja Vega / Rioja, Spain

9.25 / 11.25 / 22.50 / 30.75

A blend of Tempranillo, Mazuelo and Graciano Grapes from the Rioja Alta area. Aged in small oak barrels for two years before a further year in bottle. A mature, graceful wine with a long, lingering velvety style.

E / Rioja Bordon Rosado / Spain

Hints of raspberry & citrus fruits. Refreshing, tasty & intense

F / Angels Flight Zinfandel Blush / California, USA

This fruity white Zinfandel is juicy and medium sweet with crisp acidity providing a fresh finish. It is perfect as an aperitif or paired with light appetizers, including spicy dishes.

1 / Condado de Haza / Ribera del Duero, Spain

62.00

Intense on the nose with aromas of black fruits such as blackberries. Slight touch of liquorice with spicy notes from the ageing in American oak. Robust with well-integrated acidity, highlighting rounded tannins that show volume and a persistent finish.

2 / Bordon Gran Reserva / Rioja, Spain

59.00

A powerful nose of ripe fruits, tobacco and leather, robust and very smooth with lots of fruit with a spicy, velvety, vanilla and persistent finish. Multi award winner.

3/ Vina Ardanza Reserva 2015 / Rioja,

62.00

An Intensely perfumed bouquet evokes ripe raspberry, cherry, potpourri, tobacco, and exotic spices, plus a smoky mineral flourish. Sweet and broad in the mouth, offering: lush red and blue fruit, spicecake, mocha and coconut flavours that firm up on the back half.

4/ Pesquera Tinto Crianza 2020 /Ribera del Duero

58.00

Soft aromas of black fruits, sweet liquorice spice & hints of coca which edge around the more powerful fruit notes. On the palate the well balanced oak maturation is very well defined, compliments rather than overwhelming the fruit.

5 / Vina Real Reserva / Rioja, Spain

47.00

Warm spices and elegant toasty oak aromas. The palate is rich and velvety with a touch of acidity and fine tannins. The vanilla from the oak is beautifully intergrated with the raspberrt fruit producing a fine and complex wine with great lengh

6 / Dashwood Pinot Noir/ Marlborough, New Zealand

38.00

Shows intense and alluring aromatics due to the long and cold growing conditions. Crunchy black and red cherry fruit are backed by winter spice, plum and vanilla. The voluptuous and aromatic fruit flavors are supported by smooth tannins, a refreshing cranberry acidity and rich velvety finish

7 / Catena Malbec / Mendoza, Argentina

38.00

Ripe, concentrated dark fruit aromas with delicate floral notes and traces of vanilla and mocha. Rich and lush on the palate, with concentrated black cherry and red currant flavours and notes of sweet spices, tobacco and a touch of leather. The palate has soft, supple tannins with a bright, crisp acidity and flinty minerality, giving the wine exceptional length.

8 / MadFish Shiraz / Margaret River, Western Australia

39.00

MadFish Shiraz draws upon fruit from ideal growing locations in western Australia and shows the South Western version of the grape in a classic juicy style, luscious, plush fruit with Exotic and savoury spice note.

9 / Chateauneuf du Pape / Rhone Valley, France

57.00

The vineyard of Pied Redal, with its pebble and sandy soils is certified organic. The blend is mainly Grenache, with Syrah, Mourvedre and Cinsault. Shows dark fruit flavours such as black cherry and blackcurrant, spiced with liquorice and aromatic herbs, the palate is full bodied with fine grained tannins which give it a smooth finish.

10 / Feudi Salentini Primitivo / Puglia, Italy

43.00

The hand-harvested grapes are fermented under temperature-controlled conditions, to prevent the juice from getting too hot and losing its aromatic fruit flavours. Aged in American barriques for about 12 months, it has an elegant and intense aroma, with notes of ripe plum, cherry jam, tobacco leaf and cocoa, followed by notes of white pepper spice.

11 / Esporao Reserva / Alentejo, Portugal

47.00

Granit and loamy clay soils define the Alentejo vineyards that provide the grapes for this intense, spicy red. Aromas of mature red berries and oak spice, the palate is full bodied with a firm tannin structure, plenty of fruit and a long finish. The label changes every year with a different artist commissioned.

12 / Bolyki Egri Bikaver "Bulls Blood" / Egri, Hungary

40.00

Attractive, deep ruby colour. The spicy nose shows a core of dark stewed fruits & chocolate. Rich palate with intense black pepper spice followed by dark cherry & blackcurrant notes with a hint of vanilla. Lively acidity, tight tannin & a long mineral finish.

WHITE WINES

13/ Bolyki Egri Csillag Eger / Hungary **40.00.**

Egri Csillag is the white wine equivalent of the famed Egri Bikavér

This Egri Csillag is a blend of Királyleányka, Sauvignon blanc, Hárslevelű and Riesling.

Enticingly floral aroma which is rounded out by citrus notes. Lively acidity with a crisp palate of white fruits and peach ends in a chalky, mineral finish.

14/ Paco & Lola Albariño / Galicia, Spain **39.00**

Expressive nose of green apples, pear and lemons, with hints of herbs and flower blossom.

The palate is clean and textured with refreshing citrus flavours amplified by minerality.

15/ Quinta de Raza Vinho Verde/ Minho, Portugal **35.00**

With a fizzy crispness and easy, fruity finish making it perceptibly just a bit off-dry, clean and invigorating.

This classis Vinho Verde is utterly delicious, with fruit quality shining through.

Quinta da Raza was established in 1791 in the sub region of Celorico do Basto.

16/ Torre dei Vescovi Pinot Grigio, Italy **38.00**

Golden yellow in colour the bouquet is delicate with complex floral notes. The wine is dry, pleasantly fresh and velvety.

17/ Chablis Domaine Louis Moreau / Burgundy, France **54.00**

Elegant refined and 'chiselled' flinty Chardonnay. Louis Moreau has been making excellent stylish food

friendly and polished Chablis since 1814 winning major awards with his hallmark flinty fresh balanced wines.

18/ Howard Park Miamup Chardonnay / Margaret River / Western Australia **41.00**

Immediate fresh flavours of melon, citrus, peach and pear are followed by a palate of brioche, vanilla and caramel on a fine chalky texture with gentle acidity

19/ CLOUDY BAY/ MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND **57.00**

In 1985, Cloudy Bay released its first Sauvignon Blanc. Thirty years on, as Cloudy Bay launch their flagship wine's 30th vintage, they maintain the same innovative spirit and devotion to quality and consistency that generated their success in that first year.

20 / SOUTHERN RIGHT SAUVIGNON BLANC / Walker Bay, South Africa **38.00**

This wine has an expressive individuality and the significant percentage of fruit from clay-rich soil, gives it a wonderful balance of fruit and minerality. It also has a generous complexity which helps to complement the wine's natural varietal fruitiness.

21 / Bordon Blanco / Rioja, Spain **39.00**

Fresh fruity flavours of citrus, green apples and stone fruit, characteristic of the Viura variety. Dry, zesty and easy to drink, it has a nice crisp acidity

22 / Esporao Reserva Branco / Alentejo, Portugal **42.00**

Golden straw colour with green tones the nose is rich and complex with fruity notes of peach tangerine and subtle barrel toast. Creamy with a well-balanced palate there is good depth of ripe fruit with elegance and minerality. The finish is long and fresh

23 / Sancerre Les Colinettes / Loire Valley, France **48.00**

Fermented at low temperature this classic Sancerre shows just how great French Sauvignon Blanc can be. The nose is rich with cut grass and blackcurrant leaf while the palate is taut and complex with flavours of candied lemon notes and racy minerality.

24/ Lagar de Cervera Albarino / Galicia, Spain **46.00**

Clean and bright colour. Extraordinary, elegant nose of white ripe fruits, apples, pears, custard apples Citrus fruit, lemon peel and stone fruit. A very balanced finish makes a perfect example of how an Albarino can be.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINE

- 25 / Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial / Champagne** **79.00**
With a toasted hazelnut & smoky rich notes, layered with fruit and has a fine smooth finish.
- 26 / Moët & Chandon Rose Imperial / Champagne** **81.00**
*A lively, intense bouquet of red fruits (wild strawberry, raspberry, cherry)
Floral nuances of rose. A slight hint of pepper.*
- 27 / Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label N.V. / Champagne** **85.00**
*A blend of up to 50 different crus mainly Grand and Premier go into the blending of Brut Yellow Label.
The initial notes of white fruits are followed by toasted brioche and vanilla
all held together by a streak of minerality and racy acidity.*
- 28 / Pol Roger Brut Reserve / Champagne** **85.00**
*Dominated by white flowers, green apple, brioche and a trace of minerality
On the palate there are notes of stone fruits, a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey
supporting the freshness of the acidity*
- 29/ Laurent Perrier Rose N.V. / Champagne** **110.00**
*Subtle forthright and very fresh on the nose Cuvée Rosé Laurent-Perrier is a lively well-rounded wine which
combines structure and freshness with an abundance of red berry fruits.*
- 30/ Philippe Fourrier Carte D'or N.V. / Champagne** *(half bottle)* **35.00**
Beautifully crafted Pinot Noir and Chardonnay blend from a highly respected 8th generation family.
- 31 / Paco & Lola Brut / Cava** **38.00**
A fresh and soft taste, notes of apples, citrus and white flowers.
- 32 / Tullio I* Prosecco / Prosecco, Veneto, Italy** **38.00**
*Straw yellow in colour. Fine and persistent bubbles, with pleasant notes of "Renetta" apple and hints of acacia flowers. Fresh
and dry.*
- 33 / Radise Prosecco Doc Rose / Prosecco, Italy** **38.00**
*An intriguing combination between Glera grapes and Pinot Nero ones, giving life to very fine bubbles embracing fruity and
floral scents.*
- 34 / Segura Viudas Reserva Heredad / Cava** **72.00**
*The opening aromas of this Cava are yeasty from ageing on its lees, smoky, with hints of brioche, followed by
touches of honey, fruit and flower petals.*
